

## Agriculture Equipment Operators Hazard Checklist

1.	<b>Roll over bars</b> are installed on tractors (unless they fall under the exceptions of <b>GISO 3651</b> (a) including low profile).					
2.	Seat belts are installed and always used on tractors with rollover protection.					
3.	Tractors have <b>positive locking brakes</b> .					
4.	There are guards on all moving parts on tractors, power take-offs and other equipment.					
5.	Parking brakes are always set when turning off and leaving equipment.					
6.	Employees are instructed not to remove or tamper with safety guards.					
7.	Ensure that <b>no extra riders</b> are allowed on tractors unless the extra rider is being trained or assisting in machine operations. When allowed, ensure extra rider is in a safe position.					
8.	There is proper clearance around the equipment before it's started up.					
9.	Engines and power sources are locked out before maintenance service, to prevent injuries.					
10.	The equipment is kept at the <b>proper clearance from power lines</b> to protect from electrocution.					
11.	Equipment is turned off when refueling.					
12.	No smoking during refueling to prevent fire or explosion.					
13.	Avoid fuel vapor inhalation when refueling.					
14.	When operating noisy equipment, <b>hearing protection devices</b> are worn as required.
