1.	Training on your Emergency Action Plan and procedures is provided whenever you modify the plan or hire new employees.					
2.	Your employees know where to find and access your plan easily.					
3.	Emergency escape and exit routes have been developed and discussed with employees.					
4.	All exit routes are well lit.					
5.	Emergency exit signs are checked monthly for proper operation and they're easily visible.					
6.	Exit routes are clear and unobstructed.					
7.	Workers who oversee the evacuation process are trained on the procedures to follow during an evacuation.					
8.	Workers know who the emergency coordinators are and have their contact information.					
9.	Emergency coordinators are trained on how to assist workers who have special needs during an evacuation.					
10.	The procedures identify who to report to and when during an emergency.					
11.	Procedures are in place on how to monitor workers after an evacuation.					
12.	A plan of action is in place if someone is missing.					
13.	Workers know where to gather after an evacuation.					
14.	Your alarm system is <u>tested and maintained</u> on a regular basis.					
15.	Practice evacuation drills are held regularly.					
16.	Workers know to only use the stairways during an emergency evacuation.
