

Eyewash Station

- Should provide room temperature water.
- Located within 10 seconds of free travel from chemical use area.
- Unit must deliver at least 0.4 gallons of water per minute for 15 minutes.
- Water flow must be between 33" and 53" from the ground and at least 6" from the wall.
- Unit must flush both eyes simultaneously.
- Water flow must be high enough for user to hold eyes open during use.
- Test unit monthly to ensure good working condition.
- Check all functions annually.
- Instruct all employees on the location and use of eyewash station.

A sign must clearly mark where the unit is located. Spray heads are **EMRGENCY** covered and easily **EYE WASH** removed by the water flow when **STATION** unit is turned on. KEEP AREA CLEAR On/off handle is easy to find and accessible to user. Valve activates within one second and stays on by itself.
