- **Display purposes**: Can be used to place display items such as plants

- Non-Self supporting
- Adjustable in length and can reach higher heights
- **Stability**—wide base and can be secured against walls
- **Requires** only two level ground support points
- **Outdoor Use**—suitable for outdoor applications such as painting houses

## Use an extension ladder for:

- Exterior work such as roofing, cleaning gutters, repairing shingles or installing skylights
- Construction projects: Assessing higher floors and installing windows
- Painting and siding installation
- Electrical work: Useful for accessing ceiling mounted lights

- Tri pod pole design
- **Provides support** on soft, uneven ground
- Lightweight—usually made of aluminum which makes them easy to transport
- **Outdoor Use**—suitable for agricultural and landscaping duties

## Use an orchard ladder for:

- Pruning trees: Perfect for pruning fruit trees or other tall trees
- Harvesting fruit: Allows workers to reach high branches while maintaining stability
- Gardening: Useful for tasks such as planting and greenhouse work
- Outdoor maintenance: Useful for trimming hedges and tree branches
